Note: This is a very long rehearsal. Please be patient, <u>bring snacks</u>, a <u>sack lunch</u>, and something to drink. This is the time to bring an old over-sized shirt to wear over costume so you don't need to change out of costume to eat or drink. <u>NO EATING IN COSTUME</u>. Hair must be in a bun with no bangs showing. Makeup is required. The 11:00 rehearsal will be a blocking rehearsal; soloists and ballet dancers will be shown where to stand on stage for each part of their dance. We will also work on light and stage cues. The 12:30 rehearsal will be a blocking rehearsal for Combo Ballet classes. At 1:15 we will set the bows for all soloists, ballet, and combo ballet dancers. The 1:45 rehearsal will be with music and lights and include the Combo classes. We can't promise that there won't be any stops so be flexible. If you are not required to be on stage, you may sit in the auditorium. Please sit with your class, as it is easier for teachers to find you. There is NO EATING IN THE AUDITORIUM! You may eat in the hall outside the side door. Please be respectful of the Bremerton High School Performing Arts Center and clean up after yourself. Parents of the younger dancers need to be aware that this is a long day for the dancers. There will be no photography or video recording allowed during the show on Sunday. A professional video will be available for sale at the Sunday performance, look for the order form at the BDC office or at the performance.
